REPORTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF MAYOR

- Thanked everyone for attending the meeting with Avalon Bay on April 16th.
- It was the first opportunity for the Governing Body and residents to see what is being proposed on that site.
- The meeting of April 16th will be shown on TV34 and copies will be available for a small fee.
- The Borough has requested the power point presentation and architectural drawings to be posted on the Borough's website; this has not yet been finalized by the developer.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES AND OTHER MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMITTEES

Councilwoman Chen-Hoerning

- Brought up the issue of visitor parking permits, which has been discussed.

Mayor DeIorio wanted to make the public aware if a resident has a medical situation that requires a caregiver; they can notify the Police Chief to make provisions. He said he would work with the Councilwoman on this issue.

Councilman Badillo said he would like to work with the Councilwoman on a pilot program.

Mayor DeIorio said the residents can circulate a petition and present it to the Governing Body.

- Councilwoman Chen-Hoerning thanked the Police Chief for addressing speeding and littering in her ward.
- April 22nd is Earth Day.
- Union County has a program for planting trees; there is one more date open.
- April 27th to 30th is National Volunteer Week. Anyone interested in volunteer opportunities can check the web site at: volunteer.unitedway.org.
- Attended a forum of Woman in Public Office at which the Mayors of Fanwood and Kenilworth were present.

Mayor DeIorio said when he first took office, he was proud to have appointed Nancy Sivilli as the Borough's first female Borough Attorney. She is now an Essex County Superior Court Judge.

Councilman Miranda

- Handicap-accessible door at the Casano Center has been installed.
- Children's Spring Break Luncheon and ceramics class will take place at the Casano Center on Wednesday, April 23rd; it is open for grades 1-5.
- Concrete pad at the First Aid Squad building has been poured and we are waiting for the delivery of the generator.

Councilman Matarante

- Congratulated everyone involved in this years High School play production of "Anything Goes." For such a small amount of kids, it is amazing how every year they put on such a quality production. He thanked the parents who volunteered to build the sets, sold refreshments, lighting, sound and all the other work and would like them to be honored at a future meeting.

- Budget process is still taking place; before the budget process began, the tax rate for residents was an increase of \$257.00. Currently, we have gotten it down to \$155 increase for a \$65,000 house. Of the \$155 increase, \$113 of that goes to 5 categories that are out of our control. These categories are: two different public pension funds, the Library which is a State mandated amount, recycle tax and State Aid. He commended the Council on the work that has been done so far on the budget.

Councilman Badillo said the most they are able to cut at this time is \$42.00.

- Councilman Matarante said he attended the Public Safety Committee Meeting, at which they discussed the promotional criteria within the Police Department.
- Requested dates for upcoming budget meetings. The CFO will be on vacation the following week. Meetings were scheduled for April 29th at 6:30 p.m. and May 1st for 6:00 p.m.

Mayor DeIorio received notice from Keith Heyman of TV34, regarding the AvalonBay meeting tapes, which will be available for viewing on Saturday at 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Councilman Badillo

- Dad's Club will be sponsoring "A Day at the Races" on June 1st and the annual "All Sports Dinner" on June 3rd.
- Attended the DOT Meeting and they discussed the median, upgrading certain areas, moving traffic along and redevelopment.
- Spoke about the AvalonBay Meeting on April 16th. It was because of the insistence of Mayor and Council that the presentation was made.
- Attended the Joint Sewer Meeting.
- Attended the Public Safety Committee Meeting.
- Attended the High School play and said they did a fantastic job.
- Called Bingo at the Casano Center.
- Donated 17 recycle cans to seniors.
- Congratulated Mike Genovese for his election to the School Board.
- Spoke with the Borough Engineer regarding projects in the town.

Councilman Yakubov

- Thanked the DPW for the work in the Fifth Ward, especially on Roosevelt St.
- Neighborhood Watch Meeting will be scheduled later this month due to the budget meetings and the meeting with Avalon Bay.
- Would like residents to express their opinions and thoughts regarding the meeting with Avalon Bay.
- Councilman Badillo, Code Enforcement Officer Carl Pluchino and he have been working effortlessly to get Valley Road cleaned up. They removed a large amount of railroad ties and the only ones remaining are the ones that cannot be recycled.

- DPW is addressing potholes and any resident who has one can be put on a list to be taken care of.
- Thanked the DPW for cleaning up the land on Beechwood Avenue.

Councilman Dinardo

- Thanked the Chief of Police for addressing speeding issues.
- Thanked the Police Department for addressing the bomb threats that took place at the High School and apprehending those who were responsible.
- Gave the name of Tim Burns as a point of contact for Warinanco Park in Roselle.
- Thanked Mr. Faria for all his years of service to the school system.
- Would like to update the bulk waste ordinance.
- There are some issues with Grant Avenue that he would like addressed.

Mayor DeIorio said regarding the bulk waste ordinance, the next pickup will be on June 19th and 20th. In order for that to take place; any changes would have to be made to the ordinance, which would then have to be introduction at the next meeting.

Mayor DeIorio said on April 28th, the Borough will be recognizing Arbor Day. For the last three years, a tree has been planted in front of each elementary school; this year it will be planted at the Middle School.

MOTION BILLS AND PAYROLLS NOT BE READ

Councilman Badillo moved that bills and payrolls not be read and passed for payment, seconded by Councilman Dinardo, all members present voting Aye, said motion was adopted.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Councilman Badillo moved at 8:30 a.m. to open the public comment portion of the meeting; seconded by Councilman Miranda and adopted.

Jacob Magiera, 612 Sheridan Avenue

- Asked when the Avalon Bay meeting will be on TV34 and Mayor DeIorio said the first two viewings will be on Saturday and they will be on rotation during the week.
- Asked Councilman Badillo how much he is being paid for Joint Sewer Connection meetings.
- Asked for an update on the legal fees regarding Romerovski. Mr. Ken Blum said legal fees for Jeff Surenian were authorized for \$175,000 and to date \$161,523.67 has been spent. Fees for Joseph Maraziti were authorized \$4,500 to date.
- Asked that Resolution #128-08 be explained. Mayor DeIorio was a resolution to extend the legal fees for the defense of Office Harold Breuninger.
- The Police Department did an excellent job regarding the bomb threat situation.
- Asked about the Leberco property. Councilman Badillo said the Board of Health inspected it and the building was clean; aesthetically, the building must be addressed outside.
- Asked about the Romerovski litigation and Mayor DeIorio said the court document is on the Borough web page.
- Asked if there are enough sewer rights to accommodate the 278 units.
- Addressed Councilman Matarante saying the FAA has issued new guidelines for the fuel reserve on airplanes.
- Seniors in the Borough are opposed to changes in the Homestead Rebate and demand Mayor and Council do something about it.
- Referred to an article in the newspaper pertaining to part-time government employees and no benefits; he also asked about pensions.

Mayor DeIorio said there was a legal review on cutting pensions. Constitutionally if anyone is already in the system, they cannot have their pensions removed.

- Mr. Magiera said Councilman Matarante should be recognized for his outstanding gesture of not receiving a paycheck for the six weeks he was away on business. He believes if a Councilmember misses a budget meeting, they should be docked for every budget meeting missed.

Glen Marczewski, 622 Sherman Avenue

- Noticed there are stores closing on Chestnut Street and the Borough should market businesses.

Mayor DeIorio said the Roselle Park Special Improvement Committee met and discussed that issue. They will meet with the Cranford SID to hear their suggestions of how they addressed this issue. He believes as the business district improves, so does the community. There will be a meeting on April 30th to introduce Chief Paul Morrison to the business community.

- Mr. Marczewski said marketing has not been done in a long time.
- Asked about the Early Childhood Development Center; not being used and the Mayor suggested he address the Board of Education about that.
- Asked about the ball fields on Webster Avenue and Mayor DeIorio said the tests are on-going and we do not want to rush the process.

- Reminded everyone of the Health Fair in Westfield on April 26th from 9-11 a.m.
- Sorry to hear about the passing of Bill Davis.
- Commented on the newly accented walls in the Library.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY IN A SAFE AND SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE, DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY

WHEREAS, the Borough of Roselle Park wishes to apply for a project under the Safe and Secure Communities Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Roselle Park has reviewed the application and has approved said request; and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the Borough of Roselle Park, for the purpose described in the application; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Roselle Park that:

1. As a matter of public policy the Borough of Roselle Park wishes to participate to the fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety.
2. The Attorney General of New Jersey will receive funds on behalf of the Borough of Roselle Park.
3. The Division of Criminal Justice shall be responsible for the receipt and review of the applications for said funds.
4. The Division of Criminal Justice shall initiate allocations to the Borough of Roselle Park as authorized by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Borough Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any/all necessary documents for the purpose of the application.

Councilwoman Chen-Hoerning said she had not seen the resolution until this evening; she had reviewed it and is okay with it.

Mayor DeIorio said this is an annual grant that is applied for under the Safe and Secure Program. It is Federal, plus State monies that help fund the Police Department at a certain number of Police Departments. The Borough has met that goal consistently for ten years or more. In the past we have received about \$60,000 and this year it has been increased. He said as long as we maintain the number of officers in the Police Department, we are eligible again.
