Vegetative Waste shall mean the following: all dead plant life, flowers, wood chips and shavings, fruit from trees (examples apple, pear, etc.), small branches (up to 2 inches in diameter and not to exceed 4 feet in length, which **MUST BE TIED AND BUNDLED**) and twigs, grass cuttings, leaves (**must be in biodegradable PAPER BAGS and/or garbage pails of 20-35 gallons. No plastic bags of any kind**) or other vegetative plants or clippings.

Excludes: large limbs (over 2 inches in diameter), tree trunks, stumps and roots.

Bulk Waste shall mean the collection of: furniture, toys, mattresses (limited 2 per address), wood (limit of two – 32 gallon containers with pieces but into 3 foot pieces except for wood doors, storm windows, storm doors, doors, windows, wood fences, lawn furniture and wood products. **Not Considered Bulk Waste:** rugs, carpeting, electronic waste, ashes, dirt, tree trunks, stumps, branches, brush, leaves, household garbage, no garbage bags, pool filters, railroad ties, rocks, stones, asphalt, concrete, closed-top drums, automobile parts, appliances (refrigerators, washers, dryers, any metal products, etc.), paint. Chemicals and materials resulting from demolition, alterations or repairs to buildings or other structures not generated by the homeowner and not generated from pickup sites requiring permits.

H (HOLIDAY) – NO PICKUP OF GARBAGE; WHICH WILL BE PICKED UP ON THE NEXT SCHEDULED GARBAGE DAY.
