2. **Generic DPW Department Responsibilities:**


- a) Continuation of faded sign replacement
- b) Continued liter pickup in downtown area.
- c) Continued white goods pickup as per taxpayer request.
- d) Continued pothole patching which will continue on weather permitting days.
- e) Street sweeping program continuing daily (weather permitting)
- f) Performing various types of tree work in Roselle Park.

3. **Non-Generic DPW Work Done:**


- 1) Deposited grease eater into all known problem areas on Westfield Ave. & Chestnut St. and lift station located at 180 West Webster Ave.
- 2) Cleaned Borough owned Parking lots of debris.
- 3) Removing and trimming trees on a daily basis as weather permits.
- 4) Cleaned catch basin tops several times for rain storms.
- 5) Maintenance of three retention basins in Roselle Park consisting of cutting of grass and periodic checks of the trash racks to remove debris.
- 6) Cleaned trash racks in Carpenter, Hawthorne, and Walnut Basins for impending rain event.
- 7) Asphalt pothole patching at various locations.
- 8) Installed the 7th and 8th bench at the library

- 9) Continued bulk a la cart pick up service in the month of December 2015.
- There have been two (2) bulk (A la cart) pickups during the month of January of 2016
 - The (A la cart) pickups started on 11/13/2014.
 - a. There have been one-hundred and thirty three (133) pickups since then.
 - b. The 133 pickups have generated \$5,200.00 revenue for Roselle Park and costing only \$1098.00 for the DPW to complete the 133 pickups.
- 10) Picked up various white goods.
- 11) Exercising of the Roselle Park Generators.
- 12) Clean, remove weeds, and cut the following areas:
- a) Dead end of Franklin Place
 - b) Along the R x R tracks on West Webster, East Lincoln Ave. and East Colfax Ave.
 - c) Town Property on Union Road
 - d) Along the bike path
 - e) Dead end of Seaton Ave. & Laurel Ave.
 - f) Grove Street
 - g) Along the fence on Hawthorne St. & Meadow St.
 - h) Lehigh Ave. along R x R tracks
 - i) East Colfax Ave. & Walnut St. opening to the retention basin
- 13) Took down the Christmas decorations
- 14) Installed new street signs in several locations.
- 15) Repaired misc. items at the Casano Center.
- 16) Performed snow removal for a storm (approx.. 30 inches) which dropped the second largest snowfall since snowfall records have been kept starting in 1869 in conjunction with the RPPD and OEM.
