
**BOROUGH OF ROSELLE PARK
ENGINEER'S REPORT
February 26, 2018**

1. CASANO CENTER GENERATOR (FEMA)

The Borough awarded a contract to Manor II Electric Inc., of Holmdel, New Jersey, in the amount of \$53,000.00 for the installation of a 60 kw, natural gas generator. The project is in the preliminary construction stage, with an anticipated three (3) month construction period. This project is partially funded through the acquisition of a FEMA grant.

2. IMPROVEMENTS TO EAST COLFAX AVENUE – PHASE 4 (NJDOT)

The Borough awarded a contract to American Asphalt & Milling Services LLC, of Kearny, New Jersey, in the amount of \$214,215.17. The project limits include East Colfax Avenue (b/t Chestnut Street and Walnut Street). The project is substantially complete, with the exception of some punchlist items, including the repairs to the existing box culvert on the northwest corner of Walnut Street. The project scope included general mill and pave operations, spot reconstruction where required, curbs, sidewalks, ADA compliant ramps and the like. Furthermore, this project is partially funded through the NJDOT FY 2017 Municipal Aid Program.

3. IMPROVEMENTS TO WEST COLFAX AVENUE - PHASE 3 (NJDOT)

The Borough awarded a contract to Cifelli & Son General Contracting Inc, of Nutley, New Jersey, in the amount of \$235,482.00. The project limits include West Colfax Avenue (b/t Chestnut Street and Locust Street). The project is substantially complete, with the exception of some punchlist items. The project scope included general mill and pave operations, spot reconstruction where required, curbs, sidewalks, ADA compliant ramps and the like. Furthermore, this project is partially funded through the NJDOT FY 2016 Municipal Aid Program.

4. IMPROVEMENTS TO WEST CLAY AVENUE (YEAR 44 CDBG PROGRAM)

On February 7, 2018, Clerk Casais and myself, presented the Borough sponsored CDBG application before the CDRS Public Improvements Sub-Committee, for the improvements to West Clay Avenue (b/t Hawthorne Street and Cedar Street (paper street)). The project scope as presented, included but was not limited to general mill and pave operations, spot reconstruction where required, curbs, sidewalks, ADA compliant ramps, driveway aprons, removal and replacement of shade trees, roadway striping, and the like. The Borough requested a grant amount of \$188,035.00.



5. IMPROVEMENTS TO WEST CLAY AVENUE (NJDOT FY 2018 PROGRAM)

As requested by the Borough, NEA submitted a grant application through the NJDOT Municipal Aid Program, for the improvements to West Clay Avenue (b/t Faitoute Avenue and Hawthorne Street) in the amount of \$373,796.00. NEA is pleased to present to the Governing Body, that the Borough was awarded \$309,045.00 for such work.

6. IMPROVEMENTS TO BUTLER AVENUE (YEAR 43 CDBG PROGRAM)

The Borough awarded a contract to Cifelli & Son General Contracting Inc, of Nutley, New Jersey, in the amount of \$186,787.50. The project limits include the entire length of the Butler Avenue (b/t Meadow Street and Locust Street). The project is substantially complete, with the exception of some minor punchlist items. The project scope included general mill and pave operations, spot reconstruction where required, curbs, sidewalks, ADA compliant ramps and the like. Furthermore, this project is partially funded through the Union County Year 43 CDBG program.

7. DPW BUILDING

This project team is progressing with the plans and specifications for the new DPW building. It is anticipated at this point in time, that contract documents will be finalized to facilitate a Summer 2018 bid advertisement.

8. STREAM BANK IMPROVEMENTS (VICINITY OF EAST WEBSTER AVENUE)

NEA is in the process of preparing the construction documents for the replacement of the existing CMU block stream bank walls, in the vicinity of East Webster Avenue (b/t Spruce Street and Walnut Street). Documents will be submitted by April 1st, to NJDEP for Land Use permit acquisition, which should enable a late Summer or early Fall construction timeframe.
