




<u>Total</u>: There were 23 EMS calls during month of April 2017 while the County was not designated for primary response. The Roselle Park First Aid Squad was designated for Basic Life Support response during the times analyzed. Of the 23 total calls, the Roselle Park First Aid Squad answered 10 (43.5%) calls and other agencies answered 13 (56.5%).




Weekend Breakout: Weekends are broken out as the most ideal time for First Aid Squad response. During the month of April 2017 there were 13 weekend calls. The Roselle Park First Aid Squad was designated for Basic Life Support response for all weekends. Of the 13 total weekend calls, the Roselle Park First Aid Squad answered 5 (38.5%) calls and other agencies answered 8 (61.5%).




<u>Total</u>: There were 33 EMS calls during month of May 2017 while the County was not designated for primary response. The Roselle Park First Aid Squad was designated for Basic Life Support response during the times analyzed. Of the 33 total calls, the Roselle Park First Aid Squad answered 16 (48.5%) calls and other agencies answered 17 (51.5%).




Weekend Breakout: Weekends are broken out as the most ideal time for First Aid Squad response. During the month of May 2017 there were 14 weekend calls. The Roselle Park First Aid Squad was designated for Basic Life Support response for all weekends. Of the 14 total weekend calls, the Roselle Park First Aid Squad answered 2 (14.3%) calls and other agencies answered 12 (85.7%).




<u>Total</u>: There were 15 EMS calls during month of June 2017 while the County was not designated for primary response. The Roselle Park First Aid Squad was designated for Basic Life Support response during the times analyzed. Of the 15 total calls, the Roselle Park First Aid Squad answered 8 (53.3%) calls and other agencies answered 7 (46.7%).




Weekend Breakout: Weekends are broken out as the most ideal time for First Aid Squad response. During the month of June 2017 there were 6 weekend calls. The Roselle Park First Aid Squad was designated for Basic Life Support response for all weekends. Of the 6 total weekend calls, the Roselle Park First Aid Squad answered 2 (33.3%) calls and other agencies answered 4 (66.7%).



<u>Response</u>: The Roselle Park First Aid Squad responds with three (3) main units (apparatus) code-named RP80, RP81, and RP82. Using the most updated statistics for 2017, unit RP81 answers the vast majority of the total calls answered by the First Aid Squad with 219 out of the total 291 (75.3%) calls answered.



<u>Unavailability</u>: The Roselle Park First Aid Squad has been dispatched a total of 607 times from January 1, 2017 to July 9, 2017. During that time period the First Aid Squad answered 291 (47.9%) dispatches utilizing all units (see chart on left of page), while 316 (52.1%) dispatches resulted in the First Aid Squad being unavailable.



<u>Timeliness</u>: Once a call is dispatched and received there are two forms of measurement to gauge response timeliness:

- (1) **Chute Time**: The time it takes the unit (apparatus) wheels to begin turning from the time a call for service is acknowledged.
- (2) **Response Time**: The time it take the unit to arrive on-scene from the time a call for service is acknowledged.
